<b>People</b>	<b>16</b>	<p><b>Panpaper shut down over unpaid power bills</b></p> <p>The Pan African Mills in Webuye Bungoma East has been closed indefinitely after KPLC switched off power to the plant over unpaid electricity bills.</p> <p>The company has been experiencing problems in the recent past and last year the senior managers urged the Government to intervene and save it from collapse.</p>
