Sunday Nation 6.4.2008	26	<p>Total to invest Sh90m in power grid</p> <p>Total Kenya plans to invest Sh90 million in fuel shortage facilities to booster power plants in Kenya, as part of a business venture that will provide additional 150MW to the national grid.</p> <p>KenGen's Managing Director Mr. Eddie Njoroge signed contracts with Triton and Total Kenya for the supply of 24 million litres of diesel per month to fuel the extra generators in Nairobi and Eldoret.</p> <p>The power source will be the Emergency Power Plants (EPPs) that were installed in 2006 to make up for hydropower shortfalls following a severe drought at the time.</p>
