<b>The East African</b>	<b>3</b>	<b>2 firms to build rural Uganda's power lines</b>
		The publication, reports that a Kenyan company Muringa Holdings and Uganda's Power and City won a lucrative tender to build power lines for the Rural Electrification Board of Uganda. Under the venture the two firms will design, supply and construct 300kms of 33KV and 183km of low voltage overhead lines in six districts of Northern Uganda in the next sixteen months.

		The report indicates that Tanzania has secured \$29.56 million from Sweden for its rural electrification project. The funds will be used in the Rural Energy Fund support, which is the four year power project and will specifically target the Kilimo Kwanza programmes.
