Once complete Lake Turkana Wind Power project will sell its output to KPLC. The two have agreed on feed-in tariff of 7.22 euro cents per kilowatt hour for 20 years.

REA's main responsibility is to provide affordable electricity to all rural areas of the country by extending the national grid.
