<b>Business Daily</b>	<b>2</b>	<p data-bbox="727 373 1495 459"><b>Nigeria and Germany sign deal to boost power supply</b></p> <p data-bbox="727 506 1455 716">Electricity starved Nigeria signed a preliminary agreement on Tuesday with Germany to help boost power supply in Africa's top oil producer in the next 11 years.</p> <p data-bbox="727 768 1503 1110">Under the deal, Germany will generate 6,500MW by 2020 after building new power stations that will include hydro, gas thermal, solar, coal, wind and waste-to energy plants in different parts of the country. Germany will also help Nigeria expand existing dams and upgrade power stations to improve power generation.</p>
