		The publication reports that the Kenya Tea Development Agency (KTDA and Ministry of Energy engineers have finalised feasibility studies for hydro-electric power projects in Kericho and Bomet counties. Shareholders of KTDA affiliated firms will spend over Sh1.1 billion to construct four hydroelectric projects. KTDA mooted the mini-hydro power initiative, together with tea factories, with the aim of "reducing operating costs, increasing power supply reliability, reducing greenhouse gas emissions and diversifying sources of revenue.
