		The publication states that KenGen is preparing to generate 280MW geothermal power. This is almost equal to the current effective power capacity in the country and will greatly enhance the reserves which have been thinning. Under the Vision 2030, clean energy is a key anchor. However so far no tangible investments has been witnessed in this area despite a lot of conceptual projects. The bidding needs to be transparent to allow for completion of two additional Olkaria I and IV units by 2013 to meet growing demand.
