

CLARIFICATIONS TO QUESTIONS RAISED BY TENDERER'S DURING THE SITE VISIT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF BOUNDARY WALL FOR KIPEVU POWER STATION HELD ON 24/08/10

Question	Clarification
1. There is no specific bill item for formwork for the works. How will this be dealt with?	The cost of formwork will be inbuilt into the cost for the supply and installation of the relevant class of reinforced concrete.
2. What type of finishing is expected to the masonry wall?	The tender provides for supply installation of masonry with keying. The stones therefore need require to be dressed.
3. Some of the drawings supplied in the tender are illegible.	Drawings will be reissued.
4. There seems to be omissions in the tender document namely, gate house and crossing over existing pipelines.	The bills are reissued to take care of the omissions as attached. These comprise Lot 1 Bill 1.1-Boundary Wall Lot 1 Bill 1.2- Guard house Lot 2 Electric Protection
5. There is no mention of guardhouse works in the tender document.	The guardhouse works are as per Bill 1.2 attached.
6. What works are expected on the existing gate as nothing is mentioned in the tender document?	Item 1.1.12 of bill 1.1 provides for painting of the 2No. Existing Gates to approved colour.
7. There is no mention in the tender document of the works that are expected at the pipe crossing at three locations.	Item 1.1.11 of Bill 1.1 provides for Supply and install metal grating where the oil pipelines cross the boundary wall.
8. Is it acceptable that bids are tendered at the Kipevu office instead of Nairobi Head office?	The procurement procedures do not allow for submission at any other office hence all tenders must be submitted to the Head office at the address specified in clause 5 of the tender document.
